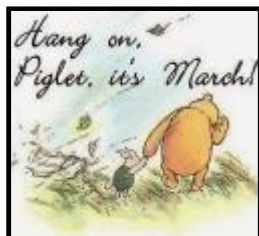
We again urge OMP members to help with some of the jobs with FMA so

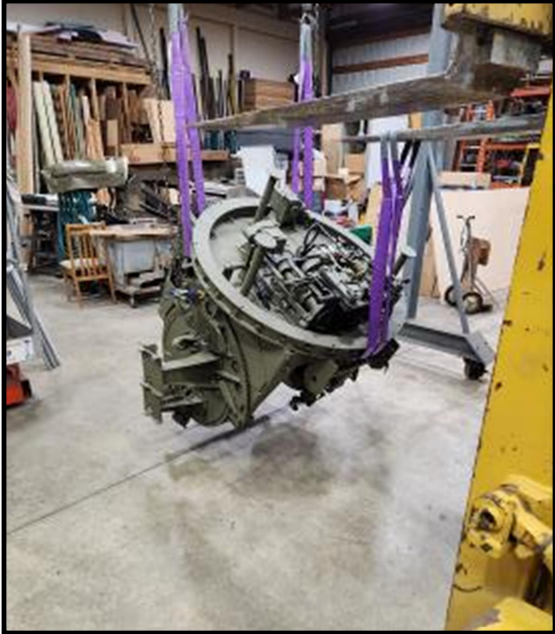
