After the meeting Matt Martini gave a presentation of Lauer Historical Farms and what it does.

Lauer is 65 1/2 acres that is in the Johnny Appleseed Metropolitan Park District. It is a working historical farm dated back to the mid 1930's through world War II in the mid 1940's.

Matt Martini, our host, brought to the farm the inspiration of telling the story of WWII. In October Lauer Farm becomes a battleground for one of the WWII skirmishes. During this time Matt has around 800 8th, 9th and 10th graders from area schools come in on Friday before the big event and have a hands on experience. He has 3 stations that tells of different portions/people of the war. They get to ask questions to historians plus see the vehicles and other items that were used during the war. It has been proven to be a great addition to the kids education. Matt said some of the kids come back both Saturday and Sunday to the show to watch and learn history.

OMP has had members participate in this event and have said only good things about the venue and the people in charge. If you remember we have had many pictures of this event and they show every aspect of the things that might have occurred during a battle from the medics to the field, a great demonstration of what happened during those times.






