Reasons for flying the flag half-staff

ADDITIONAL REASONS FOR HALF STAFF PROCLA-MATIONS:

- Death of a principal figure in the U.S. government
- Death of a local government official
- Death of a foreign dignitary
- Death of a military person
- Death of a civil servant

WHO ISSUES HALF STAFF PROCLAMATIONS?

The President and state Governor's issue half-staff orders for government properties. Orders will state when and how long the U.S. flag and/or state flags should be flown at half-staff.

TYPICAL HALF STAFF FLAG FLYING DURATIONS:

- 30 DAYS after the death of a President or Former President
- 10 DAYS after the death of a Vice President, Chief of Justice, Retired Chief of Justice, or Speaker of the House
- 2 DAYS the day of and the day after the death of a Congress member
- UNTIL BURIAL after the death of an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Secretary of a Military Dept., Former Vice President, or a State Governor.


