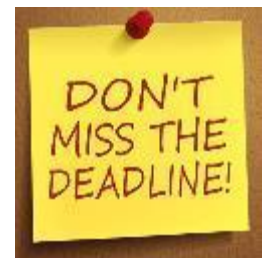

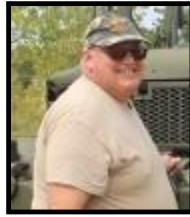
President Says...Hi Folks,
